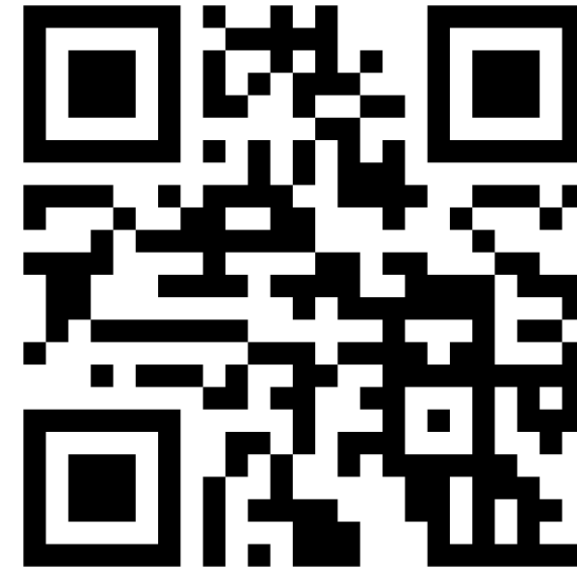
Registration

- Once registered, **the captain can add team members** and mentors in the application directly.

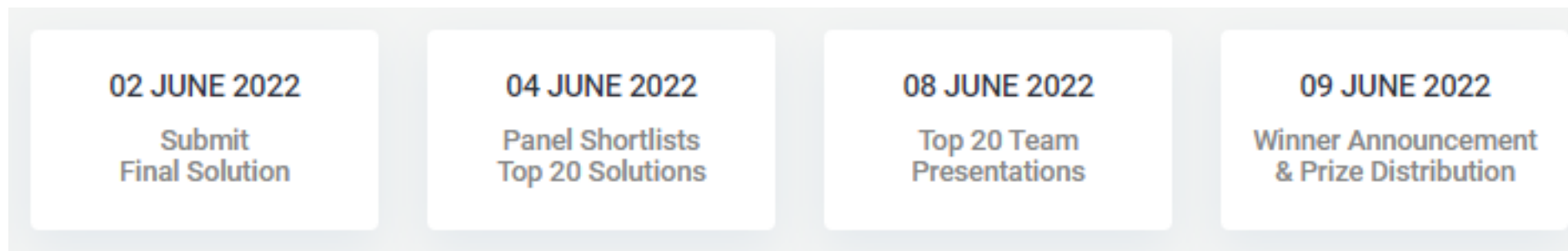

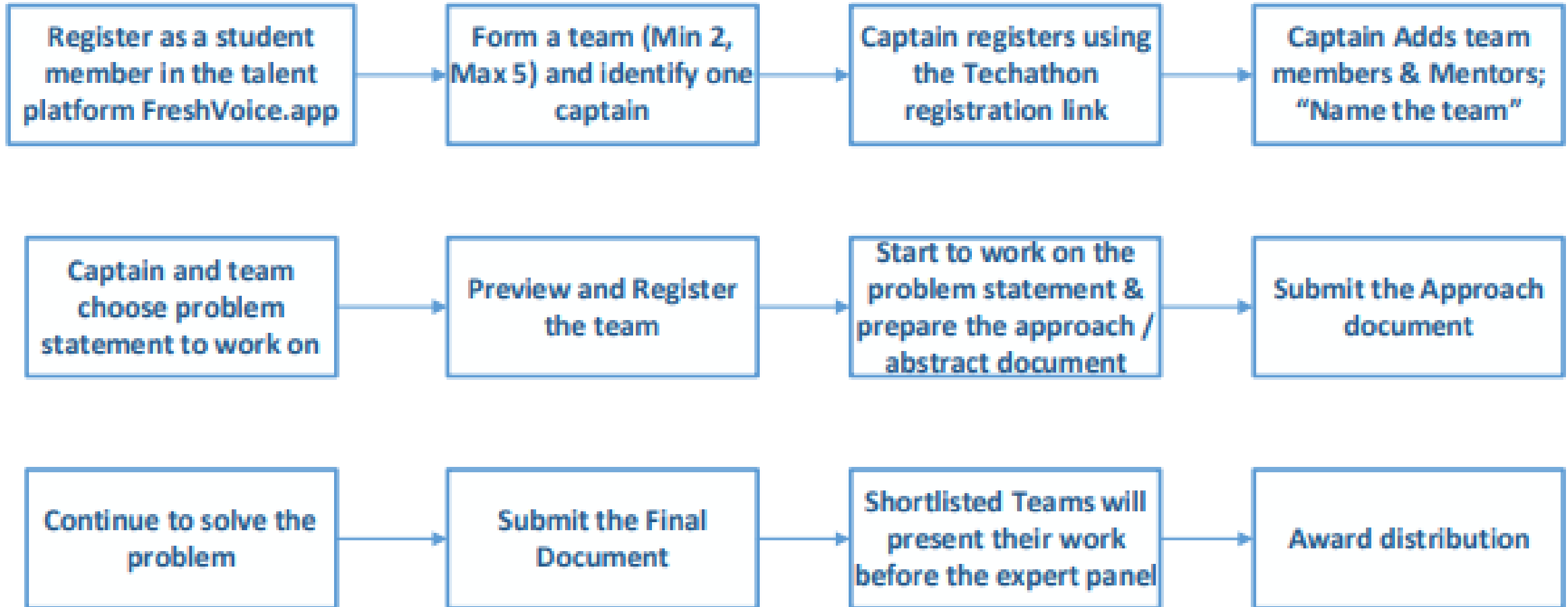
Note: Registration & Abstract submission dates are Flexible till 30th May 2022

- Registration Last Date and Abstract Submission Last date provided are the intermediate milestone that helps the team. These dates are FLEXIBLE till 30th May 2022– as long as the team has the confidence to complete the work and able to submit the abstract by 30th May 2020 and have a line of sight to submit the final solution as per the last date for final solution submission.

End to End Process Steps




Simplified Registration

- STEP 1: Decide your team members first
- STEP 2: Discuss with your team on which problem statement you are planning to work on (for handy list of problem statements, you can download the same from the event details website)
- STEP 3: Decide who is going to be your mentor (this is optional)
- STEP 4: Select one person from your team as Captain
- STEP 5: Captain to register his/her name in the event registration page. One he/she registers, can be able to add the team member name and the mentor's name.
- STEP 6: Each of the team member are requested to go and take a free membership in www.freshvoice.app (student sign up) – This will be mandatory for successfully registering the team
- STEP 7: Captain, upon sign into the event page, need to add the team member, give an attractive name to the team, select the problem statement and register
- STEP 8: Captain shall submit the abstract document, support documents (if any) and final documents using the event application itself.



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
Important Note

- You can add or modify your team member / mentor / team name till the time finally register the team.
- Same way, you can select a problem statement & save. You can have a change in your choice till the time you register the Team.

Once registered, you will not be able to change the above

- You cannot submit the abstract or final document until your team is successfully registered.
- For **Successful registration** of your team, the following are to be in place
 1. One captain + minimum 1 member or Maximum 4 member (team size is not less than 2 or greater than 5)
 2. All the members in the team, including captain – need to have their registration as free member in www.freshvoice.app
 3. Mentor selection is optional. If using a mentor, only one can be added as a mentor
 4. Choice of Problem statement completed




